ANALYTICAL PROFILE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

The dept of Occupational Therapy first of all has harmonized its quality policy with the quality policy of the University of Western Macedonia, taking actively part at the Quality Assurance Accreditation procedure by the Hellenic Authority for Higher Education (https://www.ethaae.gr/en/) in the period between 14-19 December 2020.

Quality Assurance for our department is a continuous effort to follow high national and international standards during the undergraduate, postgraduate studies and during research. The dept applies reliable recording and internal evaluation of research and studies procedures that drive the decision-making, after taking also into account national and international Good Practices.

Some indicative activities are:

- (A) The registration to the European Network of Occupation Therapy in Higher Education (ENOTHE) from the first year of operation and participation to all of its actions.
- (B) The Configuration of the undergraduate studies program in close cooperation with the Greek and the Cypriot Occupational Therapists Associations.
- (Γ) The beginning of the procedure for certification by the World Federation of Occupational Therapists (WFOT).

Scope of the department

The dept of Occupational Therapy of the University of Western Macedonia has as its aim to promote and develop the OT science through Advanced Education and Research. A main scope is to supply to its students the necessary skills for them to be successful in their professional and research career.

The dept is newly established with the Greek Law 4610/2019 – ΦΕΚ 70/A/7-5-2019 and it is the second department of its kind in Greece.

The site of the dept is https://ot.uowm.gr/ and it has a Greek and an English menu, where anyone can find the undergraduate courses in Greek and in English and a detailed study guide in Greek and in English.

The dept pays special attention to the Clinical Placement. For this purpose, it has established a close cooperation with the Greek and Cypriot OT Associations and through them, it has managed to supply to its students the possibility to attend their clinical placement on site or through e-presence to almost 35 clinical structures (special schools, hospitals, elderly residences, etc).

Our dept has adopted the ECTS credit units, as stated at the study guide. All the regulations
